

Where are column charts available in Jalapeno?

Column charts are available in all Insight tabs.

What type of data items can I present as a column chart?

You can use a column chart to present data about most item types in a Jalapeno model.

How do I interpret what the column chart is showing?

If the selected *Stack by* value is a relationship...

The chart presents bars, one bar per value of the *Chart by* selection. The overall length of the bar shows the total number of items in the population relating to the *Chart by* value. Each of the stacked bar segments is a count of the items for one value of the *Stack by* selection. Stacked bar segments are click-able as each value of the *Stack by* selection represents one model item.

If the selected *Stack by* value is an attribute...

The chart presents bars, one bar per value of the *Chart by* selection. The overall length of the bar shows the total number of items in the population relating to the *Chart by* value. Each of the stacked bar segments is a count of the items for one value of the *Stack by* selection. *Stacked bar* segments are not click-able as each value of the *Stack by* selection represents one attribute of model items.



Jalapeno Quick Reference - Column Chart

Can you show me an example?

In the example shown here, the population consists of the project tasks related to a selected program. Each stacked bar represents the project tasks for one assignee (*Chart by Assigned to*). Each bar segment shows the count of project tasks for that assignee for one priority value.
