

Jalapeno How To - *Create a sprint*

Where do I find sprints in Jalapeno?

Projects can be found within the Project Delivery module of Jalapeno.

After selecting the “Projects” menu item select the ‘Model’ tab and the “Sprints” sub-tab of the Project model.

How do I add sprints?

Sprints are added via a grid and not a tree. To learn how to add, edit and import items into Jalapeno grids and manage them in bulk, view this [guide](#).

How do I add additional information to each sprint?

Within each sprint (each row) in the grid, you are able to add the sprint name, the release that the sprint will be included within, the start and end dates for the sprint and the epics or improvements that will be addressed within the sprint.

What are the essential parts of the sprint that need to be modelled?

There is very little in Jalapeno that is mandatory. You may model as little or as much as is needed. However, sprints must have start and end dates, be assigned to a release and have enhancements or epics to deliver for them to show up in roadmaps. This information can always be added at a later date if it isn’t immediately available.
