

Why link an external process to a process in Jalapeno?

Many organizations have an established process inventory with process detail stored elsewhere, in other tools. Jalapeno is able to link to these processes, maintaining only the processes hierarchy in Jalapeno. This retains the ability to provide traceability between processes and the rest of the business operating model.

Where do I find processes in Jalapeno?

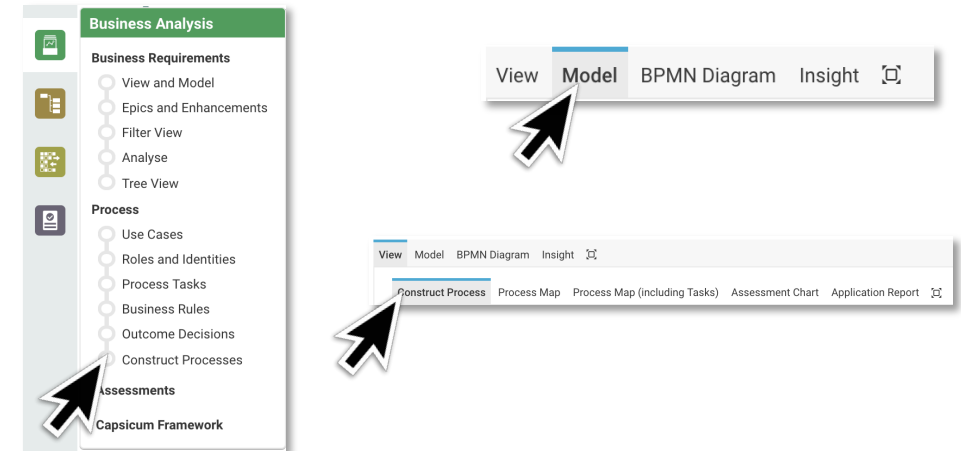
In the Business Analysis module, select Construct Processes from the Business Analysis module.

Go to the Model tab.

To create the process, select the parent process from the tree and click the 'Add Process' button in the top right corner. Enter a process name and an optional description and click 'Save'.

How do I create my process inventory in Jalapeno?

Jalapeno stores much of its content in taxonomies, or trees. Processes are maintained in this way. For information about creating, maintaining and managing hierarchies in Jalapeno, please refer to this [guide](#).



How do I link my external process to the a process in my process inventory in Jalapeno?

Select a process from your process inventory / tree in Jalapeno.

Select the 'Model' tab and the 'Detail' sub tab.

Expand the 'Extra' header and type in or paste the URL for your external process into the "External Reference" field. Remember to Save!

How do I view my external process from my process inventory in Jalapeno?

Select a process from your process inventory / tree in Jalapeno.

Process that link to external processes will have a link item displayed to the right of the process title. Clicking tee link will open the URL in a new browser tab.
