

What are Roles and Identities?

A Role identifies the actors in a domain and their designated Responsibilities as they embark on an endeavor. Responsibilities are assigned rights by way of entitlements which govern the participation of Roles. Roles are played by an Identity.

Where do I find Roles and Identities?

Navigate to the Business Analysis module and click on Roles and Identities.

How do I add Roles and Identities?

Create a Role - In the 'Create Roles' tab, click on the Add Role button . Add a label, an optional description and click save. The newly created Role will show up in the Role tree.

Create an Identity – Click on the 'Create Identity' tab and select the 'Add Identity' button . Add a label, an optional description and click save. The newly created Identity will show up in the tree. The identity must also be related to the party that it is capacitating. At the Capacitates Party property click on 'Add item', select the Party to link to and click save.

How do I link an Identity to a Role?

Select the desired Identity in the Identity tree and select the the 'Create Identity' subtab. At the 'Plays Role' attribute click on 'Add item', select the Role to link to and click save.

What are the essential parts of a Role or an Identity that need to be modelled?

There is very little in Jalapeno that is mandatory. You may model as little or as much as is needed. However, when using Roles in Process modelling, Roles need to be linked to Identities and Identities to Parties.
