

What does the Enablement Roadmap show?

The enablement roadmap (ER) extends the presentation of initiatives/projects along a timeline to also include;

- The business capabilities expected to be uplifted by each project
- Technology elements related to the uplifted business capabilities which are directly impacted by each project
- The level, or extent, of anticipated uplift and impact resulting from the execution of the project

The ER provides delivery teams with a view of the business impact of their activities and promotes the inclusion of business impact and business priorities in delivery planning considerations.

What do I see when I first open the ER?

On opening the ER, the view displays all projects (items of type PROJECT) having start and end dates which have related uplifted capabilities.

By default, all project items are collapsed (as shown by the image on the right). Each project item is shown as a bar, labelled with the name of the project. Projects are shown along a timeline according to their start and end dates.



What are the items shown in the ER?

The items shown in the roadmap are shown on the right.

The mock-up on the right indicates the items which become visible when a project item is expended. When project items are collapsed, the items within projects are not visible.

In what ways can I modify/constrain/optimize the ER ?

Manual timeframe selection (right-hand side of header)



In the entry fields provided, specify the start date and end date for the timeframe to be displayed using the pop-up calendar picker.

Button Label	Function
	Displays the 2 month timeframe starting from the current date and time. The button is not visible if the current date is earlier than the earliest project start date, or later than the latest project end date
	Displays the timeframe according to the selected start date and end date. The button is disabled if the selected timeframe is already being displayed.
	Move ahead or back by the timeframe selected

Pre-defined timeframe selection (left-hand side of header)

The controls available on the ER include a set of timeframes. These are as follows:

Control Label	Function
1 month	Displays the 1 month period starting from the specified start date.
2 months	Displays the 2 month period starting from the specified start date.
3 months	Displays the 3 month period starting from the specified start date
1 year	Displays the 12 month period starting from the specified start date
All	Displays the timeframe from the earliest project start date, to the latest project end date. This is the default timeframe for the view.
Fiscal year 2020	With Jalapeno v1.26.0, this is fixed as the calendar year 2020.



How can I explore detail of the elements shown in the roadmap?

Expand / collapse projects

A project may be expanded and collapsed by clicking on the down-arrow shown at the right extreme of the project bar.

Inspect projects (vertical inspector)

An expanded view of a project may be displayed in a dialog by clicking on the icon to the left of the down-arrow on the project bar. The dialog presents the expanded project showing the contained items in a vertically scrollable column. The dialog provides a means of viewing the detail of a project without adjustment of the roadmap timeframe.

To close the dialog, click on the roadmap outside of the dialog.

Click-thru on elements within projects


Items impacted by the project (shown with a white background in an expanded project) can be inspected by clicking on their label. Detail for the clicked item is presented in an inspector dialog over the roadmap view. On closing the dialog, you are returned to the roadmap.
